

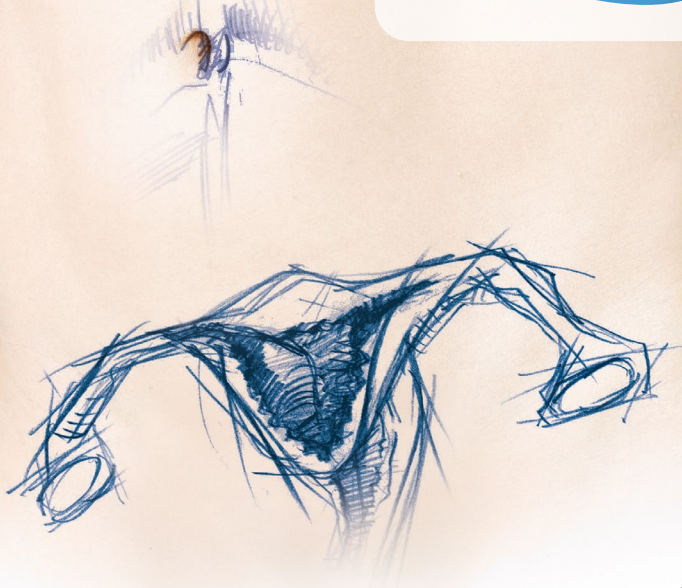

Today our surgical spectrum includes almost all fields of gynecological endoscopy (i.e. benign gynecology, endometriosis, urogynecology, gynecological oncology).

With around 12.000 surgeries annually, the Frauenklinik an der Elbe is one of the largest institutions of its kind worldwide.

Additionally we are committed to teach endoscopy and share our clinical experience with gynecologists. We trust in the benefit of sharing and exchanging surgical techniques and knowledge with colleagues, also for our benefit.

The German Working Group of Gynecological Endoscopy (AGE) strives for medical and surgical excellence and has established a graded certification process in Minimally Invasive Surgery (MIC) for their members. Amongst the number of performed laparoscopic surgeries, attendance at endoscopic meetings, participations in endoscopic workshops and trainings and visits to

other hospitals are part of the MIC certification criteria, which range from MIC I to MIC III.

Experienced MIC surgeons can establish teaching and training centers under regulations of the AGE. Our institution is one of the twenty-two defined AGE teaching centers in Germany.

Our workshop curriculum of basic and advanced courses is based on the concept of the AGE and fulfills all requirements for the AGEs MIC accreditation.

With 5 colleagues having the highest accreditation MIC III we guarantee clinical excellence, experience and high quality practical training in small groups.

During the course, you will join us in theatre, attend all relevant hysteroscopic and laparoscopic surgeries and have a close interaction with the surgeon and theatre staff. Because of our high number of performed surgeries, you can change within the theatres to follow the procedures of your preference.

Additionally, presentations on surgical techniques and theoretical knowledge will provide you with the latest medical evidence.

We are looking forward to welcoming you in Hamburg at the Frauenklinik an der Elbe.
